As a private pilot, your airplane can take you anywhere you please. Fly friends to the beach. Fly your kids to the mountains. Fly to a different city every weekend for dinner. Now that's freedom. Flying can take you places you never imagined.



How do I get started?

The adventure begins with your first flight lesson, your "Introductory Flight", to familiarize yourself with the airplane, our airport, and with the flying environment. During introductory flights, the student sits in the left seat, and flies for a majority of the flight. The lesson consists of half an hour of flying, and half an hour with an instructor on the ground. For only \$125, you begin the adventure of a lifetime.



You can start at any age, although you must be 16 to solo and 17 to get a pilot certificate.

After that, you can progress to an instrument rating, maybe begin a career in aviation with a commercial license or flight instructor's certificate, or explore the fun of tailwheel flying, gain a deeper understanding of flying through our world-renowned Emergency Maneuver Training® program, or discover the thrill of aerobatic flying.

How much time do I need to earn a Private Pilot certificate?

On average, about six months. A minimum of 40 hours of flight instruction is required by the FAA, (the national average is 75) and you must study to demonstrate understanding of concepts for the knowledge and oral exams (typically 40 hours of study material).



Lessons consist of a combination of flight time and classroom learning. We recommend you fly at least twice a week, and plan time to private study of the material.

What written tests and flight tests are required to earn my Private Pilot certificate?

Student pilots complete a pre-solo knowledge quiz, private pilot computerized knowledge test, and a practical exam (flight test).

Once you have your Private Pilot certificate, the adventure is just beginning!

What is the average cost of obtaining a Private Pilot certificate?

The cost varies by the type of aircraft used for training, and the frequency of lessons, but the average cost is between \$13,325 and \$18,000.
